

THE PROVINCIAL **TRAUMA COURSE**





Capacity per Course = 15 This course is open to individuals who are involved in the care of a trauma patient: staff physicians, nurse practitioners, RNs, paramedics, residents, respiratory therapists, LPNs.

Course Objectives

- Prepare and organize the trauma team and bay: a focus on pre-brief.
- Identify local resources, limitations and barriers to providing care.
- Improve the confidence and ability of participants in the initial resuscitation of a trauma patient.
- Review and practice commonly used trauma skills.
- Define the relationship and answer questions related to the rural trauma facility and the regional trauma system.
- Establish the importance of effective communication amongst team members.
- Identify ongoing site-specific learning needs and develop a follow-up plan.
